
It is relevant to mention here that 4 similar cases are still pending in the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India. The matter to give pension in all such cases has already been examined at length and it was decided to refer the case to Secretary, Law Department, GNCTD, for advice as to whether the pension in other cases is to be allowed on the basis of court's orders passed in similar cases. Accordingly, the case was referred to Secretary, Law Department, GNCTD, for legal opinion.

Now, the legal opinion from Law Department, GNCTD, has been received in this Corporation and the matter is under consideration of Management/DTC Employees Superannuation Pension Trust/Board of Directors.


However, it is mentioned here that there are about 400 such type of cases.
